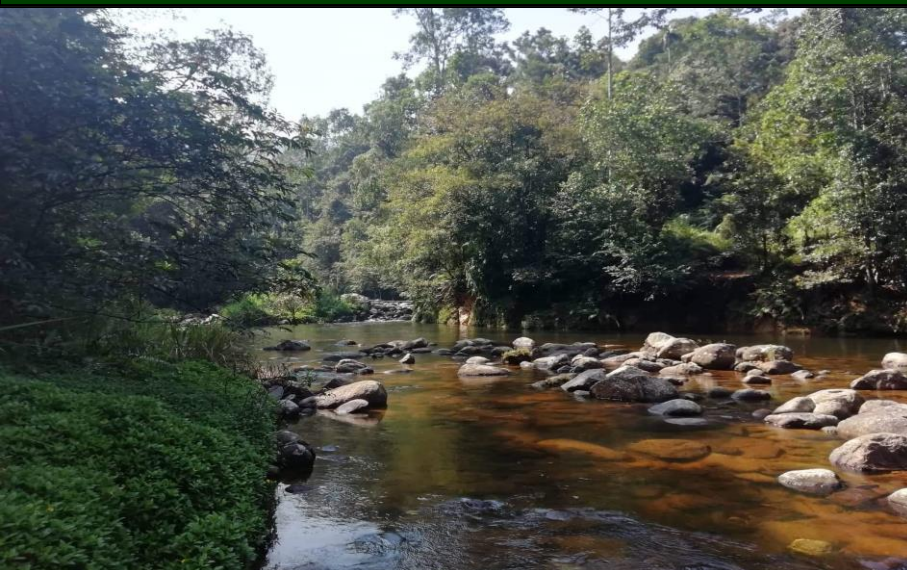


Save Real Acres of Rainforest in Sri Lanka



Rainforest Protectors Trust focuses on saving real acres of rainforest in Sri Lanka through purchase & permanent protection of privately held forest lands within buffer zone of Sinharaja World Heritage Rainforest and creating forest corridors to connect fragmented patches of rainforest. Having lost more than 95% of the original rainforests, we are fighting against time to protect what is remaining to prevent a complete collapse of the ecosystem.

Benefits of Protecting Real Acres of Rainforest

- Contains high diversity of flora, many that are endemic and endangered species.
- Already provides habitat to wildlife.
- Long-term cost of reforestation surrounding wet zone rainforests is very high due to very difficult terrain and rapid takeover by invasive species. Protecting existing forests in danger of being clear-cut provides instant results for same long-term cost with less effort.
- Only option to protect riverine rainforests since Sinharaja has lost its rivers which now flow through these privately held forest land.
- Donors can visit the lands and use trails for non-destructive recreational purposes.
- 4+ acres of riverine forest protected in 2018.
- Currently 600+ acres of forests on sale.
